

The Supplier's audited financial statements, showing, among others, the Supplier's total and current assets and liabilities, stamped "received" by the BIR or its duly accredited and authorized institutions, for the preceding calendar year which should not be earlier than two (2) years from the date of bid submission;
- 12. Latest Income Tax Return (for monthly or quarterly tax remittance) (Only tax returns filed and taxes paid through the BIR EFPS shall be accepted)
- 13. Latest Business Tax (Percentage tax or VAT) Returns (Only tax returns filed and taxes paid through the BIR EFPS shall be accepted)
- 14. Duly Notarized Certificate of Exclusive and/or Authorized Distributorship
- 15. Certificate of Good Standing, Completion, <u>AND</u> Acceptance from PHC (Any hospital equipment). Said Certification must be issued within the past twelve (12) months from bid submission. (This is applicable only to prospective bidder <u>with</u> previous contracts and completed projects with the PHC entered into within the past three (3) years from the submission and receipt of bids); **OR**
 - Duly Notarized Certificate of Good Standing, Completion, OR Acceptance from at least one (1) previous client (Any hospital equipment). Said Certification must be issued within the past twelve (12) months from bid submission. (This is applicable only to prospective bidders **without** previous contracts and completed projects with the PHC.
