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I. PERSONNEL

1. All pulmonary fellows attending to patients in the OPD are required to be in PPE (Level 2)
2. All personnel shall strictly adhere to the Hospital Infection Control guidelines

II. GENERAL GUIDELINES:

1. Pulmonary fellows will see patient with registry symptoms in the DAPA Hall Pulmonary Clinic daily 8:00 AM to 2:00 PM and 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM
2. All patients requiring laboratory tests or radiographic study will be referred to the emergency room. (As per initial general PHC OPD guidelines)
3. All patients are required to wear mask at all times while in the OPD.
4. All patients screened from the general OPD with scheduled pulmonary follow-up will be seen in the pulmonary OPD clinic on Tuesdays and Fridays 1:00- 5:00 PM.
5. Since the pulmonary room in the OPD is small, only 2 patients are allowed at a given time. No companions are allowed inside the consultation room.
