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I. STATEMENT OF THE POLICY

Home Instructions for COVID-19 Recovered Healthcare Worker – is a tool utilized by nurses to provide health instructions for Covid-19 recovered healthcare workers for discharge

II. POLICY GUIDELINES

- 1. The nurse shall accomplish the demographic information as to:
 - 1.1. Name of employee (Family Name, First Name, Middle Initial)
 - 1.2. Age. Sex, Birthdate
 - 1.3. Unit, Room/Bed No., Hospital No.
 - 1.4. Attending Physician
- 2. The nurse shall write instructions for medications with regards to:
 - 2.1. Name of medications
 - 2.2. Dosage
 - 2.3. Timing
 - 2.4. Actions
 - 2.5. Considerations
- 3. The nurse shall tick (\Box) instructions for exercise and activities.
- 4. The nurse shall tick (□) instructions for treatment and write the number of days the employee should remain on home quarantine.
- 5. The nurse shall tick (\square) instructions for hygiene.
- 6. The nurse shall tick (□) instructions for OPD / Infirmary Check-up and write the date that the employee should proceed to the Infirmary to secure clearance.
- 7. The nurse shall tick (□) instructions for diet and write the type of diet and examples on the space provided.
- 8. The nurse shall tick (□) instructions for social / sexual / spiritual instructions and write the contact details of person who can provide psychological support for the employee.
- 9. The nurse shall explain additional instructions for discharge.
- 10. The nurse shall put a name stamp and affix her signature on the space provided.
