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I. STATEMENT OF THE POLICY

This policy shall serve as a safety precaution for healthcare personnel while using the UVC disinfection machine.

II. DEFINITION OF TERMS

UV LIGHT – Ultraviolet Light is a type of electromagnetic radiation that can be used for disinfecting water, surfaces, and air.

UVC - The most hazardous deep ultraviolet light. It is also referred to as Germicidal Light.

III. POLICY GUIDELINES

- 1. Healthcare Personnel shall be oriented / trained in the use of UVC disinfection machine.
- 2. The Engineering Department shall orient the healthcare personnel regarding the Safety Reminders during use of UVC disinfection machine (See Annex A).
- 3. UVC disinfection machine is used for disinfection purposes. It is used in addition to routine terminal cleaning.
- 4. Personnel should ensure that the room is terminally cleaned prior to UVC disinfection machine.
- 5. Staff must use appropriate PPE while manipulating the UVC machine.
- 6. PPE should be readily available and cleaned between users or personally allocated to each user.
 - 6.1. UV Protective Eyewear/Goggle or UV-absorbing fullface Shield
 - 6.2. Gloves
 - 6.3. Healthcare Personnel should wear lab coats that fasten securely at the wrists and up the neck so that no skin is exposed.
- 7. Staff must limit time and distance when working with the UVC Germicidal Light.
- 8. Warning label should be placed at the entrance before operating the UVC Germicidal Light.
- 9. Keep the UVC Germicidal Light in the provided protective case or metal guard after use.
- 10. UV Germicidal Light is requiring 30 minutes to 1 hour to a 23 25sqm for disinfection.
- 11. The area shall remain vacant for 15-30 minutes after UV light disinfection.

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Annex A

SAFETY REMINDERS USING UVC GERMICIDAL LIGHT

- 1. Never view the UVC Germicidal Light directly. It is not advisable to look directly at any distance.
- 2. Keep exposure time to a minimum. Keep as far away from it as practicable.
- Hazard warning sign should be placed at the entrance to indicate the presence of UVC Germicidal Light.
 - Caution: UV Radiation Hazard. Use only with shielding in place. Protect eyes and skin from exposure to UV Light.
- 4. Eye and face protection must be inspected both regularly or before each use for damage or defects such as cracks, bleaching and replaced when necessary.
- 5. Do not touch the UVC Germicidal Light while working.
- 6. Do not use lamp near paper, cloth or other combustible material.
- 7. Bulbs should be wiped on a monthly basis with a soft cloth and dampened with alcohol.
- 8. UV lamps should be checked periodically with a UV meter (approximately every six (6) months to ensure that the appropriate intensity of UV light is being emitted for Germicidal Activity.
