I. OBJECTIVE

To standardize the screening and management of patients scheduled for OPD-Coronary Angiography and Percutaneous Coronary Intervention.

II. SCOPE

This guideline applies to all patients scheduled for OPD-Coronary Angiography and Percutaneous Coronary Intervention at Philippine Heart Center.

III. GUIDELINES

1. All patients scheduled for scheduled for OPD-Coronary Angiography and Percutaneous Coronary Intervention should be informed by their AP/Interventional Cardiologist of their schedule ahead of time for appropriate preparation.
2. Antigen testing shall be done instead of RT-PCR GeneXpert testing **on the day** of the procedure. The request for antigen test should be given to the patient by the AP/Interventional Cardiologist prior to the procedure or on the day of the procedure for appropriate charging.
3. Patients should be screened at the Central MAB triage prior to going into Philippine Heart Center Swabbing area.
4. Only patient scheduled for procedure shall undergo rapid antigen testing. Swabbing Schedule will be Monday- Sunday 8:00-12:00pm.
5. Patient's companion may stay in the designated waiting area only. No testing needed for companion.
6. Once the patient has negative RAT result, the procedure will be done at the dedicated Cath lab room (Room 5 or 6).
7. For patients with positive RAT result, asymptomatic/mild symptoms, the following should be applied:
 - 7.1 If vaccinated, complete 10 days of isolation prior to procedure
 - 7.2 If unvaccinated, complete 14 days of isolation prior to procedure
8. No repeat testing should be made for previous recovered asymptomatic patients (within 3 months of positivity with official result)
9. Any concerns not covered shall be referred to the Incident Command Post.
