## PHC HCWs: League of Modern-day Heroes



#### **PAPRs For Our HCWs**

The PHC equips our frontliners with Powered Air Purifying Respirator (PAPR), a type of respirator used to safeguard workers against contaminated air. PAPRs consist of a turbo respirator, breathing tube, hood and flow teste which actively removes (filters) a sufficient proportion of these hazards, and then delivers the clean air to the user's face or mouth and nose. These PAPR will be given to ER Special Triage staff.




