
Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Requirement

BASIC HYGIENE MEASURES FOR EVERYONE INCLUDE: Physical Distancing, Good Hand Hygiene, Cough Etiquette, Regular Cleaning and Disinfection, Avoid touching Face, Eyes, Nose and Mouth.

COVERALLS EYE PROTECTION RESPIRATOR MASK (N95) • Clean GLOVES PATIENT CARE AREAS catering GOWN • 2nd Layer GLOVES either Suspect, Probable or If going inside the patient's room Confirmed COVID-19 patients FACE SHIELD • APRON For splash generating procedures ONLY (COVID UNITS and COVID ER) (Suctioning, Intubation) HAND HYGIENE HIGH **Areas performing** CAP • EYE PROTECTION / FACE SHIELD **INVASIVE PROCEDURES** RESPIRATOR MASK (N95) or PAPR SHOE COVER Sterile GOWN • Sterile GLOVES (OR and CV LAB) HAND HYGIENE



^{*} Other PPEs aside from the medical mask should NOT be worn when roaming around PHC premises except during transfer of COVID-19 patients.
